



The Dumpster Co. Adds Portable Toilet Rental to Its Middle Georgia Service Lineup

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The Dumpster Co., a locally owned and operated roll-off dumpster rental company headquartered in Jackson, has expanded its offerings with the addition of portable toilet rental for construction sites, outdoor events, and home renovation projects across middle and north-central Georgia. The new service brings on-site sanitation under the same roof as the company's established roll-off dumpster business, giving contractors, event organizers, and homeowners a single local source for both debris removal and portable restrooms.

Co-founded in 2020 by Daniel Conway and Joe Hardin, The Dumpster Co. has built its reputation on flat-rate service, upfront answers, and dependable delivery throughout Butts County and the surrounding region. The company serves communities that include Jackson, McDonough, Locust Grove, Covington, Conyers, Griffin, Forsyth, Greensboro, Madison, Eatonton, Milledgeville, Stockbridge, Hampton, Flovilla, Jenkinsburg, and Monticello. Portable sanitation is now available across that same footprint, with delivery typically scheduled within 24 to 48 hours.

The expansion answers a request the company had heard repeatedly from its customer base. Job sites that already rely on a construction dumpster rental for debris frequently need clean, reliable sanitation for their

crews as well, and until now those customers had to coordinate that piece separately with another provider. By adding portable restroom rental to its own catalog, The Dumpster Co. lets a contractor set up a full job site with one phone call rather than juggling multiple vendors and delivery windows.

"Our customers were already calling us to rent a dumpster, and a lot of them were asking where they could get a portable toilet for the same site," said Joe Hardin, co-founder of The Dumpster Co. "It never made sense to send them somewhere else for something we could handle ourselves. Now they get the crew a restroom and a roll-off container in the same call, from the same local company they already trust."

The service covers a full line of portable sanitation equipment sized to different needs. Standard portable toilet units, the familiar porta potty that most crews picture, are the go-to choice for construction sites and come equipped with a hand sanitizer dispenser, ventilation, and a waste holding tank designed for high-frequency daily use. For sites and events that must meet accessibility standards, the company offers handicap accessible units built to ADA requirements, featuring a wider doorway, added interior clearance, grab bars, and a lower seat height. Standalone handwash stations, restroom trailers with flushing toilets and running water, fresh water tanks, and supplemental holding tanks round out the lineup, allowing the company to outfit everything from a two-person renovation crew to a full-day outdoor event.

That range reflects the variety of situations the company expects to serve. Construction and demolition sites remain the core use case, in part because federal safety rules set clear expectations. OSHA guidelines call for one toilet unit for every 20 workers on shifts under three hours and one unit for every 10 workers on longer shifts, which means even modest crews need dedicated sanitation on hand. Beyond construction, portable restrooms fill a practical gap at festivals, farm events, outdoor weddings, family reunions, and fundraisers, where guests need facilities and no permanent restroom is nearby. Home renovation projects are a third common scenario, particularly during bathroom remodels or major additions when a portable toilet on the property keeps contractors out of the homeowner's personal bathrooms for the duration of the work.

For customers who are unsure how much equipment a given project calls for, the company is emphasizing guidance over guesswork. A construction crew of 10 or fewer workers generally needs a single standard unit, while a crew of 10 to 20 typically requires at least two. An outdoor event of under 100 guests running four to six hours usually calls for two to three units, and a full-day event of 100 to 250 guests may need five to seven. Factors such as alcohol service, longer durations, and remote locations can all push those numbers higher, and the company encourages customers to call and talk through the details before committing to a count.

Consistent with the flat-rate transparency that has anchored the brand since its founding, The Dumpster Co. is applying the same no-surprises approach to its portable toilet rental pricing. Rates vary by unit type, rental duration, delivery location, and how often a unit needs to be serviced, and the company provides an exact

quote before anything is scheduled. For longer rentals, routine pumping and restocking are built into the arrangement, so a unit stays clean and stocked throughout the rental period rather than becoming the customer's responsibility to manage.

Hardin framed the addition as a natural extension of the company's local roots rather than a departure from them. "We are still the same company doing the same thing, which is making a messy job easier for the people in our community," Hardin said. "Whether that is hauling debris off a site in Griffin or dropping a clean restroom at an event in Greensboro, the goal is the same. We show up when we say we will, we tell you the price up front, and we take the headache off your plate."

The process for booking a portable toilet mirrors the company's dumpster rental workflow. A customer calls or requests service, describes the project along with the number of people and the dates, and receives a confirmation of availability and price. The company then delivers and places the unit, provides regular service for longer rentals, and returns to remove the equipment once the project or event wraps up.

The Dumpster Co. serves customers throughout the surrounding middle and north-central Georgia region.
